End of Day Dismissal

Here's a brief outline of how we dismiss children:

- Bus riders are delivered to each bus in the bus lane by the teacher. At the busy loading and unloading times only staff members are allowed on the bus walk.
- Walkers go to the front lawn. Some meet siblings there, some meet parents there, and many big kids (grades 1 – 5) walk home on their own. If you park on the street and walk up to get your children, please meet them in front of the school.
- Kindergarten students being picked up by a parent or sibling in the building will meet in room 12 outside.
- Car Pick-Up kids go to room 8 at the north end of the school entrance to be delivered to cars by school personnel. This area is only for students who get into a vehicle. We are not set up to dismiss children to adults who walk up. This is a tough job and the two staff members on duty have their hands full getting everyone where they should be and monitoring who gets into what car. Students with appointments or emergency pick-up plans (mostly) go sit inside the office.
- We ask that you <u>not</u> use the back drive driveway, (behind Post Office) from 7:40-8:15 AM and 2:15-3:00 PM. Our buses are dropping off and picking up students and it's not safe for our students to have cars moving at the same time.
 Please use the front door for drop off and pick up.

All our procedures are designed to keep students safe, to maximize instructional time (by minimizing the time we spend in getting kids to buses, cars, etc.), and to ensure an efficient end of the day for all 400 students.

If your student's after school plans are different one day, please send a note! Without a note, the teacher will send the child home the normal way. <u>Please limit</u> phone calls to emergency changes only.

Thank you for helping us make dismissal time as smooth as possible for everyone.

Reminder, calls for students who are absent will occur automatically everyday in the morning If your student is going to be absent—please call before **8:30** AM and we will mark the absence in the system and you will not receive the automated call.

Please be aware that buses often run late the first week of school as drivers teach bus rules, verify their rosters, and ensure students are picked up and delivered to the correct locations.



Policies for Grade School Students Attending High School Football
